From Our School Leadership Team,

Curriculum Day Friday March 9th No students at school on this day. Camp Australia will operate a long day program and parents are asked to use their website to make a booking or enquiry.

Our school values guide the way in which our learners, the staff and the CJC community work together. They are Harmony, Integrity, Love of Learning, Respect and Responsibility. In the coming weeks we will be sending home some values related material that the Department of Education has developed to support school communities as they work towards having their values guide the work undertaken across the school. Simple things like “please”, “thankyou” and “excuse me” are foundational elements of a strong value system. When families come to the front office, phone the office or engage with staff we have a clear expectation about the standard of conversation that would clearly reflect our school values.

Last Tuesday evening we welcomed 32 parents and friends of our school to the Annual General Meeting of the Parents Committee. Such a strong turnout tells us that there is a groundswell of parent engagement and the positive messages conveyed during the evening were a reflection of the work undertaken over the last months. The PC are looking for volunteers, convenors, organisers and helpers across the year and we are asking you to consider what role you will be playing over the coming years at our school. The swimming program is well and truly underway and the level of engagement, achievement and participation is very reassuring for staff and organisers. Our swimming carnival was a great school event and today the District carnival was held at the Carnegie pool. Our students competed really well and represented our school with distinction. I enjoyed the chance to watch some events and meet our families at this District sporting event.

Last Monday we welcomed Mr David Southwick (local member of State Parliament) and Stephen Loyer to our morning assembly to formally acknowledge the school leaders and present their badges. This important school event acknowledges the student leaders and creates expectations for these young people as they lead the school and support their fellow students.

The term 1 Principal forum was held yesterday and the focus of the day was around developing the capacity of staff to make the greatest impact possible during the learning journey for their students and themselves. High impact teaching strategies were discussed, peer observation models were highlighted and learning principles were provided so that schools could reinforce or develop their approaches to the art of teaching. I was greatly relieved to see that our AIP has an element of a whole school teaching model and now the DET has formally released support materials for schools to undertake this important work.

Policy

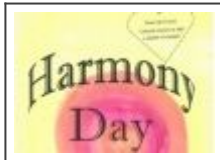

Students, wear a splash of orange or dress up in your cultural colours.

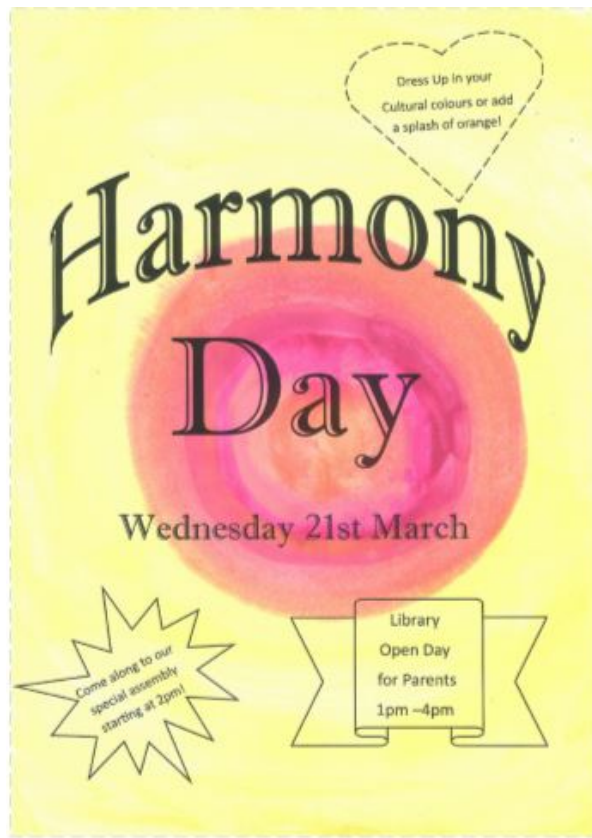

3.30 - 4pm - The library will remain open until 4pm - All parents/carers and students welcome.

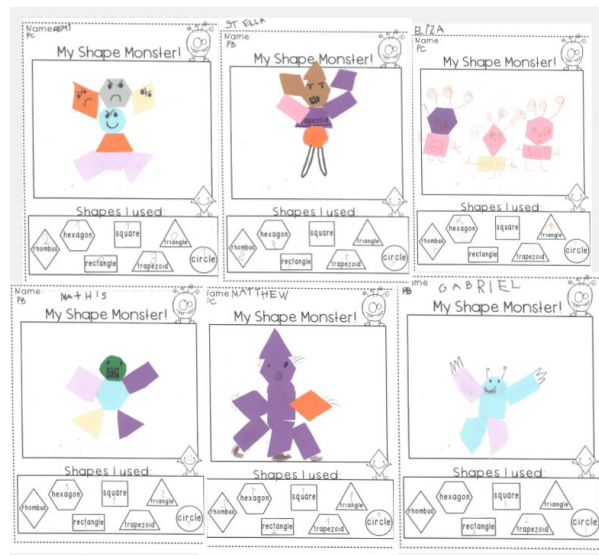

Calling all Prep families for 2018. Please see below regards, CSEF payment and Winter Uniform Package.

All Foundation (prep) students eligible for the Camp, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF) are automatically eligible to receive a winter uniform package.

Applying for the uniform pack

Families cannot apply directly to State Schools' Relief. Applications on behalf of families must be made by your school.

The uniform package includes:

- 1 x rugby top, windcheater or long sleeve polo top
- 1 x tracksuit pants
- 1 x pair of shoes

CSEF applications will be accepted up until the last day of term 2. (The earlier the better 'though) Once we receive your application, we will be able to apply for the Winter Uniform Package on your behalf.

Further information

Families who are struggling with costs for school uniforms, textbooks or shoes but are ineligible for CSEF or have children in other year levels may also be eligible to receive assistance from State Schools' Relief.
