Council of International Schools Preparatory Visit

This year we will be involved in a 'Preparatory Visit' from the Council of International Schools (CIS). The vision of the CIS is:

"...to inspire the development of global citizens through high quality international education: connecting ideas, cultures and educators from every corner of the world."

Caulfield Junior College gained accreditation with the CIS in 2004 and is proud to have continued to meet the international standards set.

Teachers will work collaboratively to analyse all practices within the school and prepare a report prior to the Preparatory Visit. We will also engage students and parents / carers to be involved in preparing feedback.

Many teachers at CJC have been involved in the CIS review process. The Preparatory Visit is an opportunity for us to reflect on where we are at as a school right now and plan for what we need to do

next to ensure we continue to be the best educators we can be.

Kenakena Exchange

We are fortunate to have built a strong relationship with the Kenakena School in New Zealand, where our students participate in an annual exchange program. In Term 4 this year, students from Kenakena will visit CJC, staying with 'host families' in their time here, attending school with us and seeing the various sights of Melbourne. We will have a reciprocal visit to Kenakena soon after.

The exchange is open to all Year 5 and 6 students. Next Tuesday 6th June, the Year 5/6 Team will be presenting an 'Information Evening' at 6:00pm in the BER. This will be a great opportunity to learn about the program and what it can offer.

We look forward to meeting interested families in Years 5 and 6 on the night.

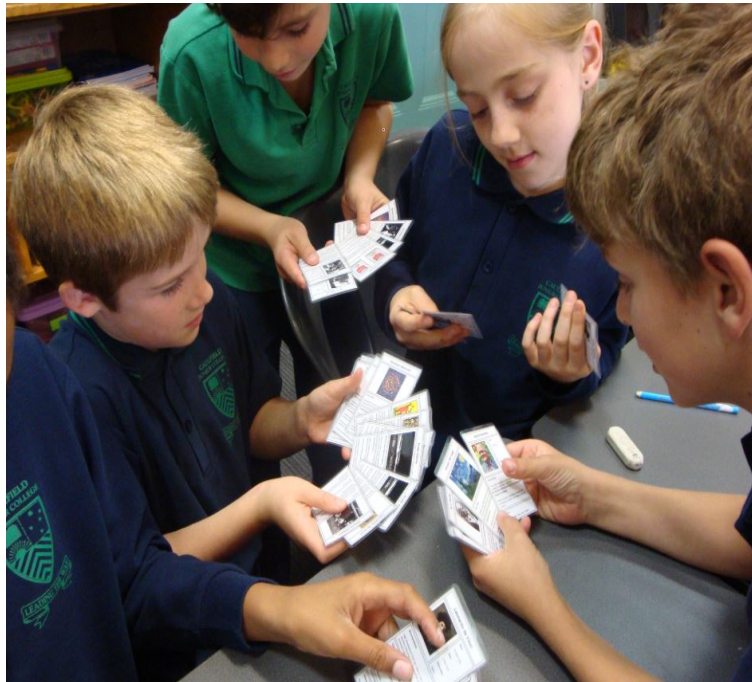
From our students,

EXCURSION/INCURSION PAYMENTS AND PERMISSION FORMS

Your child will participate in many excursions and incursions throughout their time at Caulfield Junior College. Excursions and incursions are designed to stimulate and motivate learning and are a highlight for many students. Parent volunteers are often required to assist on excursions and requests are made via the classroom teacher.

The cost of the extra-curriculum Excursions and Incursions that occur during the year are covered by the Key Experiences Levy- most families pay this in full. On some occasions other activities are offered which require separate payment. If you receive an Excursion or Incursion Permission slip that has a payment slip attached, it means that payment is required at the Office before your child can attend or participate. As always if you are experiencing financial difficulty please contact the Office BEFORE the event.

Standardised 'Permission Notification Reports' are sent home to parents when their child is to attend an incursion or excursion. The notes include details of the excursion/incursion including date/s, destination, transport method, adult responsible and the cost. This note also includes personalised student details – please ensure that all the details are current.

Parents are required to sign the 'Permission Notification Report' and include an emergency contact number for the particular excursion/incursion to which the note relates (the 'Permission Notification Reports' must be taken by the class teacher on the excursion).

'Permission Notification Reports' and relevant payment must be returned by the due date of the excursion/incursion. **THE RETURN DATE IS STRICTLY ONE WEEK PRIOR** to the event, as this is generally when we need to confirm numbers. If a signed permission slip or payment is not received by the return date, your child cannot attend or participate. Parents will be notified by the classroom teacher in this instance.

Students must be dressed in full school uniform when attending excursions. Students are seen as ambassadors for our school and dressing neatly reflects a sense of pride as well as making it easier to identify our students.

NO DOGS ALLOWED

Please be advised that as of Monday 5th June it will not be permissible for dogs to be on the school grounds at any time – including after hours and weekends.

We thank you in advance for your cooperation and understanding.

The last day of term is Friday 30th June.

School finishes at 2.30 pm. Please arrange to collect your child early, or make arrangements with Camp Australia.
