**COUNTER SALES:** at Kingston Arts. The Box Office is located in the ground floor foyer of the Kingston City Hall, 985 Nepean Highway Moorabbin (Cnr South Road) Payment options: Cash, credit cards, cheques or eftpos at the counter.

**PHONE SALES** – Box Office number is **9556 4440 (press 1 for the Box Office)** Please have your credit card ready. Please note that credit card bookings over the phone incur a \$3 booking fee and tickets are posted out the same day.

**BY POST:** Using cheque or money order. Tickets can be *reserved* over the phone and held for 3 working days, in which time Kingston Arts Centre must receive a cheque or money order for the tickets. Cheques or money orders should be made out to Kingston Arts Centre and posted directly to them at 979-985 Nepean Highway, Moorabbin 3189.

**PLEASE NOTE:** All tickets purchased within 10 business days will be held at the box office for collection prior to or on the day of the concert.

*Lekach or Hana's Honey Cake recipe below:*

*Ingredients:*

*2 eggs*

*1 cup of water (200 ml) with 2 tablespoons of instant coffee*

*230 ml oil*

*250 gr honey*

*230 gr sugar*

*500 gr flour*

*7gr of baking powder*

*1 tablespoon of cinnamon*

*1/2 teaspoon ground cloves*

*Preparation:*

*Preheat oven to 160 (fan forced) or 180 degrees.*

*Mix sugar and all the liquid ingredients in a bowl. Add the dry ingredients and mix all well. Put in a cake pan and bake 45-60 mins until cooked.*
