Message from the Charity Club of CJC

This year, we have been promoting Meat Free Monday. We would like to encourage you to avoid meat on Mondays and here is why. A United Nations report states that emissions from livestock make up 18% of all greenhouse gas emissions while other studies have found the percentage to be as high as 51%. That is more than every form of transportation combined. Two of the gases they produce are methane and nitrous oxide. Methane is twenty times more powerful than carbon dioxide in terms of global warming potential, and 37% of the emissions from livestock are methane.
