There are four sessions:

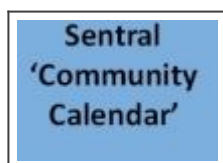
1. Wednesday 10th May – Prep Parents

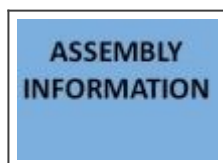
Prep Information Evening
